Race regulations:

FISTC CART Race Rules (<http://www.fistc.com>).

Dog Identification:

All dogs must be micro-chipped before entering the race area.

Dog vaccination:

All dogs must be vaccinated against rabbies, distemper, parvovirus and kennel cough before entering the race area. The vaccinations certificates must be less than 12 months old.

Dog age:

All dogs entering the race must be at least 18 months old at the first day of the competition.

Classes and distances:

Canicross	3.9 km
Bike and scooter	3.9 km
D	3.9 km
C	5.6 km
B	5.6 km
A	12 km
O	12 km

Titles will be awarded to women's teams in canicross, providing there are at least 5 such teams in the class.

The distances can be modified from the organizations according with the FISTC Officials

Nominations:

The FISTC allows all medal winners at the 2007 FISTC CART European Championships to participate in the 2008 European Championships as preselected participants.

Each member federation in good standing with FISTC (all dues paid) is entitled to nominate as many teams as it wishes for each class. The FISTC Council may, under certain circumstances, grant permission for entry (wild card) to a qualified driver who is not holding a passport from one of the FISTC member country.

Entries:

All entries, mushers and dogs, must be submitted through the inscription page of the web site.

The deadline for the entries is 11 November 2008. No entries will be accepted after this date.

Modifications to starting lists are allowed only according to FISTC rules.

Other required documents (i.e. Competitor Waiver Forms, Competitor Information sheets, copies available on this document) shall be delivered by the team delegates at the latest at the first delegates' meeting in Bueriis on 21 November 2008.

The entries, musher and dogs, must be done using the Inscriptions Area of the race web site: <http://bueriis2008.fimss.com/portals/28/inscriptions/>. These inscriptions will be immediately forwarded in real time to FISTC Officials.

I shall not hold FISTC, FIMSS, the local authorities, the sponsors liable for publishing the results of such drug testing. If the results of the drug testing prove that forbidden substances have been administered to myself and/or any dogs I enter in the Event, I agree to return all trophies and/or prize money awarded to me. Should an analysis of sample B be requested, I agree to pay for the cost of this analysis.
